

Our Curriculum

Gather Round: Hearing and Sharing God's Good News is the curriculum used by all the children's Sunday School classes, preschool through 8th grade.

This is a Bible-based curriculum "nurturing children, youth and adults in becoming followers of Jesus: people who know and love God, interpret God's word, belong to God's gathered community, and share God's good news."

With this curriculum all classes study the same lesson written for their age level.

For the 2006-2007 Sunday School year the topics are as follows:

Fall – Creation and Covenant
(Genesis)

Winter – Promise and Fulfillment
(Luke)

Spring – Living the Good News Together
(Luke and Acts)

Summer – Parables of Jesus
(Matthew and Luke)

Children under the age of 2 are welcome to join their parents in any of the adult Sunday School classes. The adult class that meets in the nursery would have toys available, but all classes are open to our youngest visitors.

Age 2 through 8th grade meet in classrooms in the basement. The classroom doors are labeled with the following age groups:

Kindergarten and 1st grade
2nd, 3rd and 4th grades
5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th grades

During the summer some classes are combined.

Children ages 2 through 5th grade meet immediately following the worship service for a singing time. The piano room is in the basement and children will go from there to their Sunday School classes.

Youth, Grades 9-12 meet for Sunday School on the second floor of the house next to the church (436 E. Chestnut). Discussion and study topics vary with the adult leadership.

The Mennonite Youth Fellowship (MYF), also for grades 9-12, meets for Bible study two Wednesdays a month. Other social events, service projects, and fundraisers are held at church and in homes.
